

Regent Park Golf Club - LOCAL RULES – (Rev: 070515)

OUT OF BOUNDS

- Beyond any boundary fence is O.O.B
- On any mown part of the academy course.
- Hole 1
 - Beyond the driving range net is O.O.B.
- Hole 7
 - Over the cart path from the white post at the corner of dog leg to the white post on approach to the green is O.O.B.
- Hole 9
 - Beyond the white posts to right of the fairway. In or over the ditch on the left of fairway.
- Hole 15
 - Left, on, or over the path is O.O.B
- Hole 16
 - Left, on, or over the path is O.O.B
- Hole 18
 - Left in or over the ditch that runs to the gate.
 - On or over the road past the gate.
 - Past the white posts around green keepers area.
 - On or over the path that runs from ninth green to tenth tee.

ENVIRONMENTAL AREA

- Hole 4
 - Beyond the line of stakes that run from the tee to the start of the lateral water hazard is deemed environmentally sensitive. As such no player may enter this area to retrieve a ball. If a ball is played into this area, a substitute ball must be played from point of entry under penalty of one stroke.

MOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- Stones in bunkers may be moved without penalty.
- Any land-fill rubble that interferes with your stance or area of intended swing may be moved without penalty.

IMMOVEABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

All of the following are immovable obstructions. As such, a drop without penalty may be taken if the obstruction interferes with your stance or area of intended swing.

- All water board furniture i.e. Manhole covers, Vent pipes. Stop tap boxes.
- All hard surfaced paths cart paths roads and foot paths (unless said path is out of bounds).
- All sprinkler heads.
- All golf course furniture i.e. benches, waste bins, marker posts (except for out of bounds posts or fences).
- Any stone filled drainage ditch that has not been topped off with turf.
- Any land fill rubble that cannot be moved.

ABNORMAL GROUND CONDITIONS

- If your ball comes to rest on any closely mown area that is totally devoid of grass, a drop without penalty may be taken within one club length not nearer the hole. This *does not include divots*.
- If your ball comes to rest in a sunken drain on any closely mown area, a drop without penalty may be taken.
- The crossings over the streams on hole 9, 11 & 12 are part of the hazard where they cross the hazard and should be played accordingly. The part of the crossing not in the hazard is a path, from which a free drop may be taken.
- The staked area between hole 4 and hole 7 is compulsory GUR. A ball played into this area must be dropped WITHOUT PENALTY at the nearest point of relief. If a ball is lost in this area a substitute ball must be dropped at point of entry.

WATER HAZARDS

- Hole 4
 - The pond to the left is a lateral water hazard. Beyond the line of red posts that run from the pond around the back of the green is a lateral hazard.
- Hole 5
 - The pond in front of the tee is a water hazard.
- Hole 8
 - The ponds in front and to the right of the tee area are water hazards.
- Hole 9
 - The ditch across the fairway is a water hazard.
- Hole 11
 - The ditch that runs from the red post along the left side of the fairway is a lateral water hazard. The remainder of the ditch across the fairway is a water hazard.
- Hole 12
 - The ditch across the fairway is a water hazard.
- Hole 16
 - The two ponds to the left of the 16th hole are both water hazards whether containing water or not.
